Treasurer report: Account total is \$6,515,72 with \$5,316.00 due on library budget.

Librarian/City presentations:

Status of storage room near meeting room (Jonathan mentioned in December possibility of storing books): The storage space has been rearranged to free up more temporary storage space to store books at the JRL.

In February we had two community event programs, one in each library. February 10th at JRL we had the African American read-in. Around 55 people attended. At the Hebron library we had the Chinese New Year celebration. Over 100 people attended.
